We are delighted to welcome Mr. M. Divyanathan, M.A., B.Ed., our new Principal. We hope that we reach the next levels of glory with best efforts.

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


MESSAGE FROM THE EDITORIAL BOARD

Silambam refers to the sound derived from swinging of the perambu a particular type of bamboo from the Kurinji hills in southern Indian sub-continent. Thus Silambam was named after its primary weapon, the perambu. The related term

Bharatham
