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# INAUGURATION OF THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2023-24

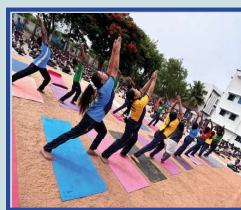
“A new day signifies a new beginning. Children want to laugh, to be challenged, to be entertained and delighted.”
