
DAY 1 (28.09.2023):

Then the students were taken to Salar Jung Museum.

We reached Salar Jung Museum by 12.30 p.m. Salar Jung Museum contains various collections. The collection has been divided into Indian Art, Middle Eastern Art, Persian Art, and Nepalese art, Japanese Art, Chinese Art and Western Art. Our students enjoyed a lot by visiting the Indian Art collection consists of Miniature paintings, Modern paintings, Bronzes,

Textiles, Ivory, Jade, Bidri ware, Arms and Armour, Stone sculptures, Wood Carvings, Metal-ware, and manuscripts. The European collection comprises of Oil paintings, glass objects, furniture, ivory, enamel ware and clocks. The students learnt a lot of information.
