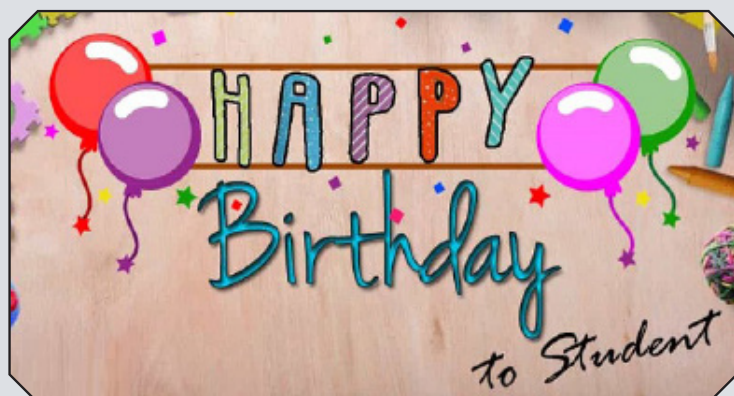

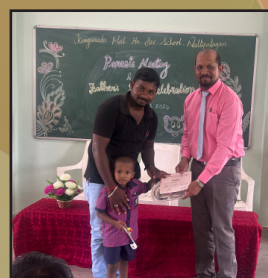

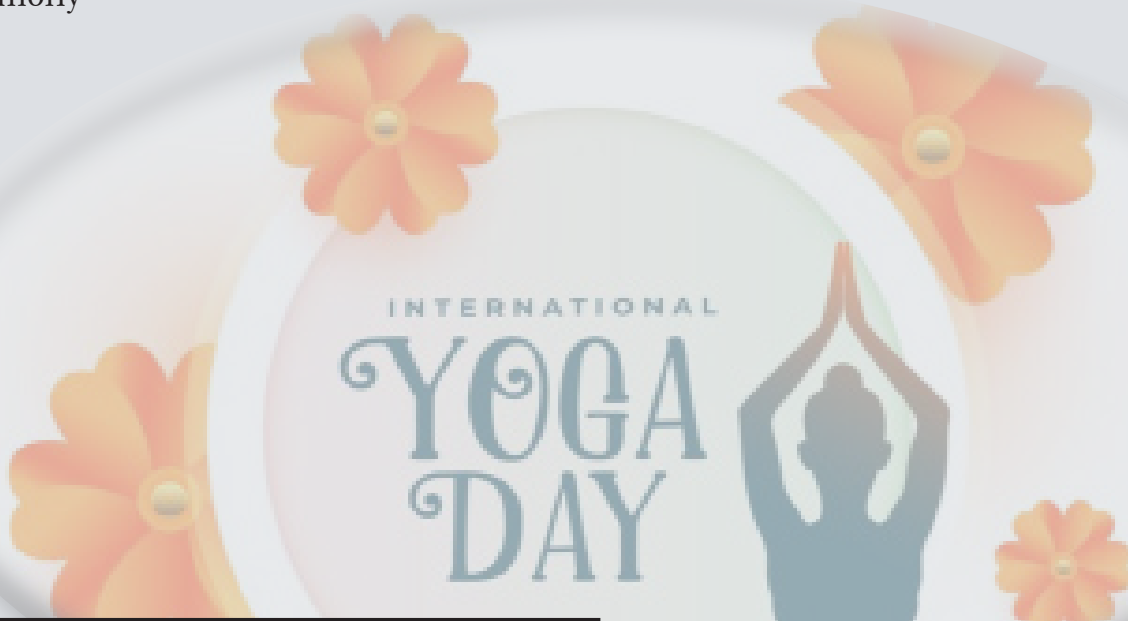
KG Father's Day & PTA Meeting

GLOBAL PARENTS DAY - JUNE 01

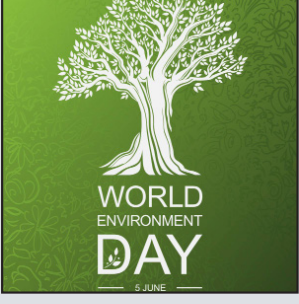

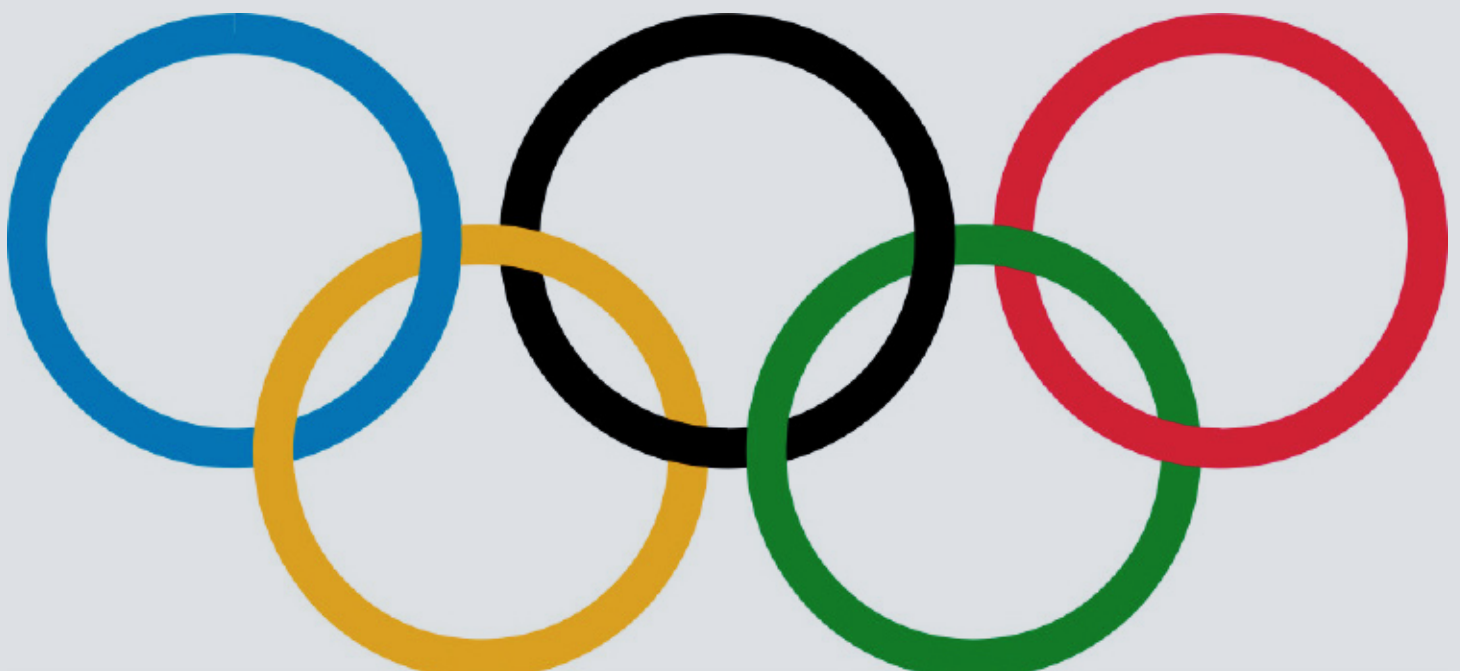

Day: Thursday

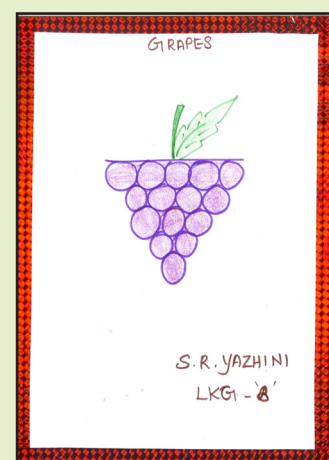
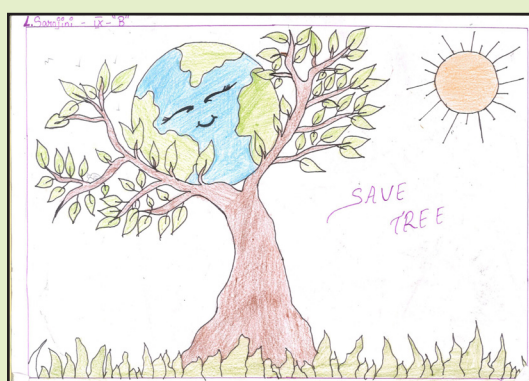
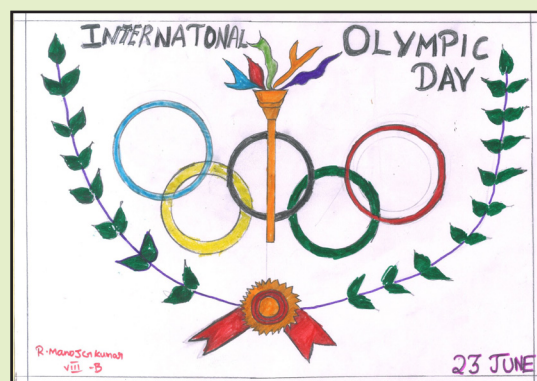
