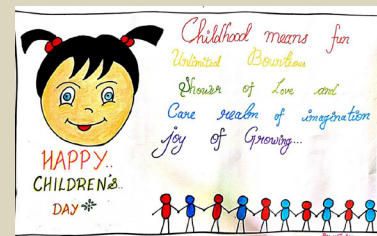
## CHILDREN'S DAY

Day 1: The students explained the meaning and importance of Gentleness.

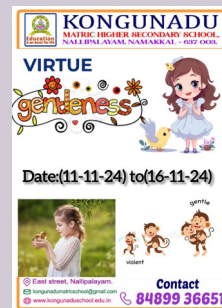
Day 2: The students recited a Tamil poem about Gentleness (சாந்தம்)

DATE: 18.11.2024 to 22.11.2024

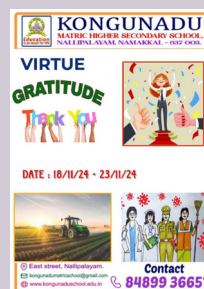
Day 1: The students explained the meaning of Gratitude as thankfulness and appreciation.

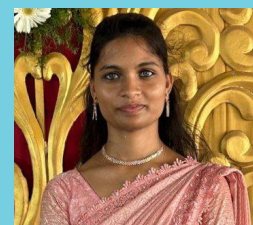
