

On 4th of February 1961 he received the highest Indian civilian award The Bharat Ratna. He was also a personal physician of Mahatma Gandhi. In the year 1976 the B C Roy National award was established in his memory.

Their contribution towards human health is beyond expectations. They are always the first to respond to a pandemic situation, such as COVID, plague flu, AIDS and others to protect the general populace.


